Curriculum Goals

Our philosophy is that children learn best through imaginative play and interactive hands on activities within a structured environment. Our rooms are set up with inviting centers that include home living, science, reading, blocks and cars, free art, easle painting, and teacher time. Teachers build their lesson plans around a weekly theme, letter, and color then use the following in an age appropriate way, to bring learning to life:

Fine motor skills:

cutting, lacing, tearing, tracing, gluing, coloring, beginning writing

Cognitive math and literacy skills:

counting, patterning, recognition of colors and shapes, object grouping, recognition of numbers, upper and lower case letters, an appreciation for books, phonics, name recognition, memorization of days and months, beginning writing, sequencing, beginning math

Social Development:

sharing, respecting others, participating in group activities, verbal expression of feelings, working on independence and confidence, self-control

Outside play and gross motor skills are also a huge part of the preschooler's world. Each class has a designated playground time each day.

Bible Curriculum

PBC Preschool feels that our first and foremost priority is to teach children that Jesus loves them. A big part of that is our daily devotions and Bible stories. Children will learn that the Bible is not only the inspired word of God, but an adventure book filled with exciting true stories that we can learn from. Teachers will use a monthly Bible theme, story, and verse to build on each day in the classroom.

To teach children how to function in a social environment with the emphasis on sharing and caring for others while building their self-esteem.

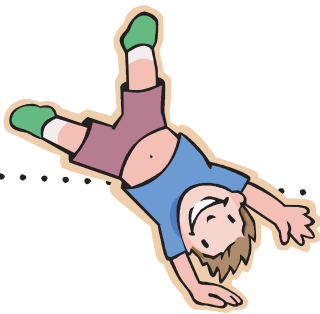
To offer parents of our church and community a program in which their children will thrive and in which they can place their complete trust.
