TOY STORE



During the month of October, we will collect monies and coats for the annual Toy Store which provides toys to needy children for Christmas in our own community. We also have volunteer opportunities. The Toy Store is a ministry under the South Yadkin Baptist Association. The SYBA consists of 70 area Baptist churches, of which Peninsula is a part. In the past 16 years, over 26,000 children have received toys through the Toy Store. We expect 2,600 children this year. Would you give?



We will collect monies through Sunday School classes and in the worship services each Sunday this month. Make checks payable to Peninsula, and mark your check "Toy Store" in the memo line or use the special offering envelopes. For each \$45 given, one child will receive toys.
