# A Word from Our Pastor



Charles Stanley had published this prayer guide a few years back and I find it is appropriate not only for our current President but also our President-elect.

## Praying for the President (or other Authorities)

2. RECOGNIZE his personal inadequacy for the task and therefore depend on Almighty God for wisdom, knowledge, understanding, and courage to carry out his task.

4. REJECT all counsel that violates spiritual principles and then trust God to prove him right.
5. RESIST the pressure of those who would have him violate his conscience.
6. REVERSE the trends of Socialism and Humanism in our land, both of which dethrone God and deify man.
7. READY himself to forsake his political career and his personal ambitions, if to do so would be in the best interest of the Nation.
8. RELY upon prayer and the Word of God as the source of his strength and the key to his success.
9. RESTORE dignity, honor, trust worthiness, and righteousness to the office of the Presidency.
10. REMEMBER to be a good example in his conduct to the fathers and sons of the land.
11. REMIND himself daily that he will be accountable to Almighty God for his attitudes, actions, and motives while serving as President.
