MISSIONS NEWS

Annie Armstrong offering being taken now through Easter
How is this offering used?



Missionary Support—70% - This money is for the structure that helps missions get started. This money supports salaries of pastors in new churches. It helps with salaries of Ministry Staff in smaller State Conventions. It pays for health benefits and training of Mission Pastors.

Church Planting Support—17% - This money helped start more than 1,450 churches in 2007. These included Language churches (like the Chinese church we hope to start here) and English churches. This money supplies Bibles, Rental Charges, Sunday School or small group literature, and a multitude of other expenses involved in starting churches.

Evangelism Support—13% - Avenues for evangelism are varied. They include church and community ministries, resort ministries, and literacy missions, to name a few. Projects that undergird missionaries' work, such as sports evangelism, Scripture distribution, special evangelism events, Internet evangelism, and media use are ways missionaries use AAEO funds to impact North America for Christ.

PBC is receiving benefit of this last area. Some of the projects put together for other areas have given us ideas for projects of our own. The North American Mission Board has given us information on how to carry these out in our own community in areas like Morrison Plantation and the Clusters.
