Text messaging with cell phones is one of the newer forms of communication that informs, involves, and connects people in today's world. Usually the messages are brief and to the point.

They are faster than a phone call, yet allow time to think before a reply is sent. There is an entire alphabet of abbreviations for savvy text messengers that make the text even more brief in characters, yet more full in meaning. With an economy of letters communication continues. Text messaging says something about our culture and the way we view life: It's a busy world, get to the point!

If your life were summed up by a text message, how would it read? Is there a Bible text that describes the life you're living? Is there a verse that you would like to live out but to do so will require some changes? Today, I begin a 4-part series of sermons on text messages that summarize the lives of 4 biblical characters: Deborah, Gideon, Samson, and David. Perhaps these messages will help you think about your life from a biblical point of view and the statement your life is making.
