A Word from Our Pastor



Wednesday evening I had the privilege, as a trustee of the IMB, to attend the appointment service of 60 men and women to become new southern Baptist missionaries. Hundreds of millions of lost people still groan under spiritual bondage unaware of God's great love for them. These newly appointed missionaries will take the story of hope and salvation and go tell the story of Jesus. Many people around the world are experiencing new hope and peace in Christ because of the witness of southern Baptists. World wide, southern Baptist missionaries recently helped their overseas partners start nearly 27,000 churches and baptize more than 565,000 new believers. These men and woman are able to go because we, as southern Baptists, pray and give to their support through the Cooperative Program and the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering for international missions. Also at this meeting of the IMB board, president Dr. Jerry Rankin announced his retirement effective July 2010.

I have been named a member of the search committee to replace Dr. Rankin. Please pray for me and my fellow board members in a special way as we seek the Lord's will in selecting the next president of the IMB.

Motions are as follows:

- The Personnel Committee makes a motion to change the job titles and position descriptions for Daniel Dye and David Simon. Daniel Dye will take on additional supervisory and job responsibilities as Associate Pastor of Faith@Home and David Simon will serve as our Minister of Adult Education & Senior Adults. Full job descriptions are available in the church office.

Upon approval by the Finance Committee, the Personnel Committee recommends an increase in pay for Daniel Dye commensurate with additional supervisory and job responsibilities. Also, to most effectively re-align our ministries under the Faith@Home model, additional hours will be recommended for the existing Children's Ministry Coordinator position. The Personnel Committee recommends that these changes in the personnel budget be made by reallocating \$5,986 (\$11,972 in all) from both Youth and Children Programs with no increase to the overall budget.
